Dear Parents and Carers,

As a family of schools Arthur Terry Learning Partnership want to support the people of Ukraine during this desperate time for them. Within our schools, staff will be supporting children to understand what is happening in Ukraine. We are now reaching out to our school communities to support an appeal for Ukraine.

We will be supporting the international response to the growing refugee crisis. All of our 19 schools will be collecting items which the Red Cross and Unicef have identified as being essential. These items are:

- Female toiletries
- New underwear for women and children
- Pet food and bedding
- Bedding/pillows
- New shoes adults and children
- Baby supplies (nappies, formula, nappy rash cream)
- Travel mugs and water bottles
- Bags (suitcase/rucksack)

We will be collecting over the next week, with items to be brought to their tutor between Monday 14<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> March. The items collected will be delivered to a regional collection hub, where they will be transported directly to Poland to support the refugee effort.

We would like to take the opportunity to thank you for the financial contributions you have already made today to Unicef through Arthur Terry school that will directly support children and families affected.

Our motto is 'Together we are Stronger' and as our school communities come together to support this appeal we can, in a small way, offer our solidarity and support for the people of Ukraine. We will share with you the results of our appeal once we have all of our items ready for collection and then share when they have arrived in Poland.
