# Year 11 Silver Award

## September 2023



#### General information

We have delayed enrolment for Year 11 on their Silver Award due to a large number of students not completing their Bronze Award and not checking the status of their Award on eDofE. Please encourage students to check that they are completing activities properly and that these are being approved on eDofE as they go thought this year at Silver level.

It is always a rush to get everyone out on a practice expedition early this term and before it gets too cold and wet - apologies for the short notice. It looks like the weather will be decent this weekend!

We then leave students to complete their other three sections of their Silver Award over the course of Year 11 at their own pace. We do not do the Qualifying Expedition until after Year 11 have finished their exams and left for the summer. Please consider this if booking a holiday. Our original plan was to do this from 29<sup>th</sup> June-1<sup>st</sup> July but may move this earlier if it affects participants taking part in the school show. We hope to confirm DofE dates next week on the school calendar.

### **Expeditions: Essential information/reminders**

- Students should pack their own bag so that they know where all of their kit is.
- Nothing should be outside of their rucksack except for a roll mat wrapped in a tough black bag to
  keep it dry. Everything inside should be wrapped in <u>several separate black bags</u> to keep everything
  dry, especially clothes and their sleeping bag. Two nights and three days means dry clothes are
  important for each day.
- Students were given an expedition manual on the Bronze training day that has all the information they need (how to pack a bag, suitable food and emergency rations to bring, our emergency mobile numbers on the front, first aid kit requirements etc.).

- Mobile phones are strictly forbidden on expeditions with the exception of one 'emergency mobile'
  per expedition group which remains turned off throughout the weekend unless there is an
  emergency.
- Please ensure you are on time as the whole group cannot leave by coach until everyone is here!

#### All students must have:

- Suitable clothing (Students will need to wear clothes suitable for walking). Jeans are not permitted. A <u>waterproof coat and waterproof trousers</u> are also required.
- For Silver you must have a pair of proper walking boots!
- Toiletries
- A Compass
- Large rucksack
- Sleeping bag and sleeping mat.

Each expedition group will also need:

- Tents of suitable size that the group can sleep in along with their rucksacks (double-skinned)
- Cooking stoves for the group (Trangia or resealable gas burning stoves please check before purchasing these to check if they are suitable, or you can hire one from us instead)
