Dear Parent/Carer

We are incredibly proud of how our Year 11 students have begun this academic year and would like to share some information with you regarding the additional support and intervention available for students to help them make progress with their revision and preparation for their upcoming GCSE Examinations.

Tutor Time Sessions

The Year 11 Tutor Team is conducting bespoke sessions twice a week during Personal Development. Students have been placed into groups based on their Year 10 Assessment Data and performance in lessons. In these sessions, they will be taught key exam skills for the subject, have opportunities to check their knowledge, and address any misconceptions. These groups will be reviewed regularly throughout the year after Assessment Series 1 and 2, and adjustments will be made as necessary. In Personal Development time next week students will also be creating a Revision Timetable. Please do ask your child to share this with you, and display it somewhere at home.

Revision Corner

The Revision Corner is now available to students in the library. This fantastic resource offers a vast array of past papers for each subject area, which students can take away and complete. We strongly encourage students to complete past papers as part of their revision. You can support this at home by helping students to find a quiet space, removing distracting devices, and setting a regular study schedule.

Afterschool Intervention

Afterschool intervention sessions will commence on Monday, 23rd September. All sessions will start immediately after school and last for an hour. Some subjects will invite students to attend, while others will offer drop-in services. Some sessions will be compulsory. We kindly ask for your support if your child is invited to attend these sessions. If a student has a clash, please ask them to speak to their Progress Leader who will advise them which intervention to attend.
