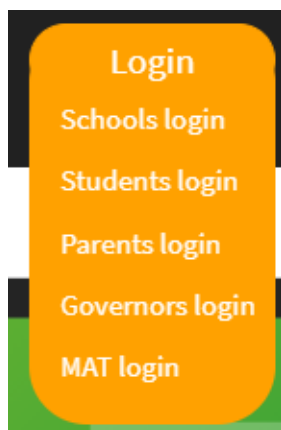
### What is GO 4 Schools

GO 4 Schools is the online system we use to enable you to view a range of useful information, including your child's progress, at any time.

Your child's page is constantly updated, providing you with the latest information.

### Logging in


Go to [www.go4schools.com](http://www.go4schools.com) to log in and from the **Login** menu choose **Parents login**:





The first time you log in select the **First-time User?** tab:

Use the **Email address** field to provide your email (that you've registered with school) and click **New password**:

If you haven't logged on to GO 4 Schools before, type your email address and click the "new password" button.

This is the password you may use to log in to GO 4 Schools if your school supports this login method.

An email will be sent from GO 4 Schools to the email address you've submitted – it shouldn't take longer than 5 minutes, please check your Spam and Trash inbox if you're not seeing this email.

In the email, you'll find a link to set a password. Your password must conform to the following requirements:

- Be at least 8 characters long
- Have not been previously used on GO 4 Schools
- Contain the following:
  - At least 1 uppercase character (from A - Z)
  - At least 1 lowercase character (from a-z)
  - At least 1 numerical character (from 0-9)
  - At least 1 special character (from @ # \$ % ^ & \*)

From now on, you can log in by entering your email address and password in the 'Sign in with Go' tab.

## Once logged in, what will you see?

Once logged in, you will immediately be able to use the links at the top of the page to see detailed information and alerts for homework tasks, messages, detentions, and reports.

The academic year can be changed from a drop-down list to show previous academic years where relevant.

The ⓘ icon will display any student data that the school has shared with you regarding your child including SEND, FSM, PPI etc.



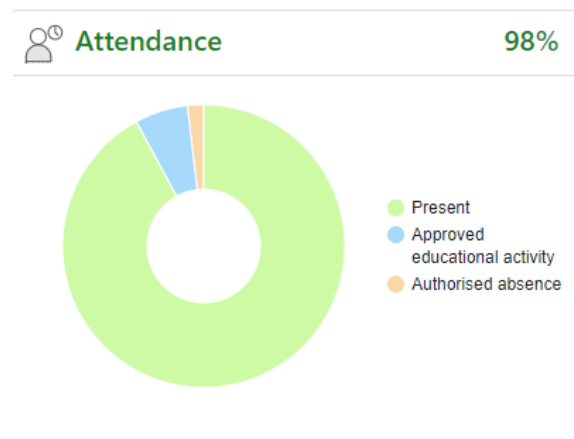
Alerts for items that have not been viewed will be displayed alongside the icons for each of these areas in GO 4 Schools.

As you navigate around the front page you will be able to see an overview of each key area, whilst clicking on the title of any area allows you to see a more detailed breakdown:

- **Timetable** – Your child’s daily and weekly timetable.

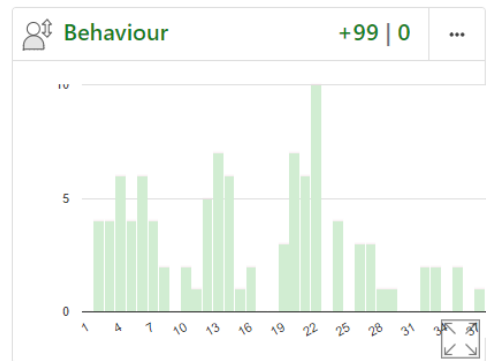
- **Attendance** –an attendance summary chart displaying the percentage of present and key absences recorded by the school for the academic year.



- **Homework** – Homework tasks due in the next 7 days. Homework information is read-only for parents/carers; however, students can mark homework as ‘Done’ to enable them to track their progress.

- **Behaviour information** – A summary of positive and negative events, plus any detentions your child has been issued.



- **Progress** – this shows real-time attainment information. By clicking into this section you will be able to view marks and target grades for all subjects throughout the year.
