### **Final Assembly and Celebration event:**

Students will come together on the 24<sup>th</sup> May after lunch for their last assembly, to have some time to reflect, and celebrate their achievements. Students will be released from school at 14:30pm, after the event.

### **Shirt Signing and Food Treats:**

- After the assembly, students will have the opportunity to sign each other's shirts. This is a tradition to capture memories and leave heartfelt messages.
- As students aren't allowed to wear signed shirts in examinations, they will need to ensure they have a **spare white shirt for signing**.

- If the exam is in the **morning**, they will enter the school site as usual through the green gates and assemble at the location of their examination.
