We are excited to inform you of an opportunity to visit the Globe Theatre on the 11th of March 2025 to watch a performance of Macbeth. This promises to be an enriching cultural experience for our students, and we would love for your child to be part of it.

Here are the key details for the trip:

- **Date of the trip: 11th March 2025**
- **Performance time: 7:00 PM**
- **Departure from school: 2:30 PM**
- **Expected return time: 12:00 AM (12th March 2025)**
- **Cost (including a ticket for the play and return travel): £36 per student.**

To express interest in this exciting opportunity, please inform us by the end of the day on the Monday 10th February 2025. Due to the expected high demand, all students who express interest will be entered into a ballot and we will notify the successful students shortly after the closing date.

Due to the start time of the performance, the show is due to finish around 8:30pm. As a result, the late expected return time means that students being picked up from school upon their return is essential. Students will not be permitted to use public transport at this time. By indicating your availability, you are also guaranteeing that provisions will be made for your child to be collected from school upon their return. If this is not possible, then unfortunately your child cannot be considered for this trip.
